1. How much are your puppies?

Puppies start at \$900 and go up to \$1,100.

2. Where are you located?

We are located outside of Ft. Smith, AR.

3. How much is a deposit?

A deposit is \$300, and it is nonrefundable. Deposits go towards the price of the puppy.

4. How do you place a deposit?

Venmo is preferred, but we also take CashApp and PayPal. However, there is a 3% fee to use Paypal. Once we receive your deposit, we will send you a deposit receipt.

5. How long is my deposit valid?

Deposits remain valid until used and may be moved to a different litter.

6. Do I have to put a deposit down?

Yes, in order to reserve a puppy a deposit must be made.

7. When do you make picks?

Picks of the litter are made at around 4-5 weeks of age.

8. How do you make picks?

Once it is your turn to pick, we will send plenty of photos and videos to ensure you make an educated decision. No picks can be made in person. Once your pick is made, your puppy is reserved and cannot be sold to another buyer.

9. Do you deliver?

Yes, we have a ground delivery service that delivers in the continental United States. Prices vary by location and are subject to change. Estimated to be around \$600-900.

10. Do you crop ears?

No, we do not do ear croppings.

11. When can I get my puppy?

Puppies will be ready for their new homes at 8 weeks of age.

12. Do these puppies have papers?

Yes. All puppies come with ADBA (or UKC) Registration papers.

13. Are these puppies American Bullies or Pitbulls?

Puppies will be registered as American Bully.

14. Are these puppies up to date on vaccinations and/or dewormings?

Yes, all puppies are up to date on vaccinations and scheduled dewormings as recommended by our veterinarian and is tracked on the puppies' Health Records.

15. What should I expect upon receiving my new pup?

Your puppy will be health checked by a licensed veterinarian, up to date on vaccinations, and parasite free. Your puppy will come with ADBA (or UKC) Registration papers, a Health Record, and a sample of the puppy's current dog food.
